

# Homeless Outreach Request

If you see a person(s) experiencing unsheltered homelessness, you can request a Street Outreach Team to ensure this person(s) is connected to our homelessness response system to be assessed for needs and connected to resources.

A health and safety assessment may also be conducted if necessary to ensure the health and safety of those experiencing unsheltered homelessness.

## WHAT IS UNSHELTERED HOMELESSNESS?

According to The US Department of Housing and Urban Development, or HUD, person(s) experiencing unsheltered homelessness “live in a place **not designed or ordinarily used as a regular sleeping accommodation** for humans.” In addition to sleeping outside of housing structures, this includes inhabiting abandoned buildings, sheds, garages, transportation areas such as train stations, camp grounds and more.
