Detroit Department of Transportation (DDOT)

Through DDOT individuals can take public transportation. Reduced Fares are offered for individuals 65+ of age, Medicare card holders (with card), and individuals with a disability. Individuals with a disability must complete and have a Professional Verification Form by a health care professional. DDOT Bus Tracker allows for real-time location and arrival times for DDOT buses. To track for bus Text DDOT and your bus stop number to 41411. Fares cost \$2 for 4-hour pass and \$5 for a 24-hour pass. For more information on fares refer to the <u>transportation fares link</u>.

Travel within a 10 mile radius of any connector services with advanced registration and reservations. Free paratransit for veterans in Oakland County with registration.
