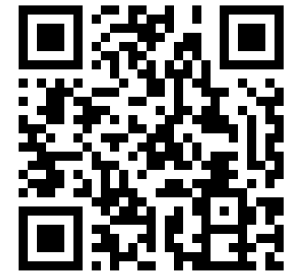


Greater Detroit Agency for the Blind and Visually Impaired (GDABVI)
